This sponsored program will enable students to learn the skills necessary to enter the health care field upon graduating from high school and excel in a career as a Medical Assistant.

- Successful completion of this program prepares students to sit for a nationally recognized Medical Assistant certification exam.
- Program combines classroom training and clinical experience for immediate application of new skills.
- Priority consideration for employment with HPH and/or other community partners for each student who successfully completes the program and passes the certification exam.

WHAT IS THE ROLE OF A MEDICAL ASSISTANT?

Medical Assistants play a key role in delivering the highest quality care to patients and their families. This includes assisting with patient care and procedures, administering medications, documenting routine office laboratory and diagnostic tests, as well as performing administrative medical office and business practices such as coding and billing.
